


KENYA, UGANDA AND TANGANYIKA






LABUAN, LAGOS. Part of Straits Settlements. Chief industry, sago. British colony, now part of Nigeria.

LEEWARD ISLANDS. A group of islands in the West Indies, those that are British being Antigua, Barbuda, St. Christopher, Nevis, Anguila, Dominica, Montserrat and the Virgin Islands.
