FOURTH PAN AFRICAN ORNITHOLOGICAL CONGRESS

Specialists from all over the world are meeting in the Seychelles with the particular aim of discussing mutual interests and furthering our knowledge of the birds of Africa and its associated islands.

The Seychelles Paradise Flycatcher

Yeuva Zosterops corom
This Paradise Flycatcher, with its two central tail feathers almost 1.2 cm less in length, is one of Seychelles' most attractive birds. It is confined to the island of La Digue where it lives in dense woodland on the wooded plateau. It feeds on insects which it catches in mid-flight.

The Seychelles Sunbird

Ceryle alcyon
The Sunbird is a lively little bird with a sharp, metallic voice. It feeds on insects and nectar. The bird is not migratory, although its perpetual search for flowering shrubs and trees causes it to be constantly on the move. It builds an elaborate nest suspended from a branch.

The Seychelles White-eye


Zosterops lateralis
The white-eye takes its name from the small ring of silky white feathers which surround the eye. The species is common to all parts of eastern Africa and its islands, although the *Madagas* of Seychelles has first seen yellow pigment common to the rest of the species. It is a very gregarious bird, living in flocks and feeding on insects, fruit and nectar.

The Seychelles Black Parrot

Cyanops forficatus
The Seychelles Black Parrot is a forest dweller, feeding on insects, fruit, leaves and nectar. It makes its nest in holes in the trees and is a very capable climber, owing to its elaborate foot structure. It has a harsh, screeching call.




