NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN BANKERS WAS FOUNDED AT SARATOGA SPRINGS, NEW YORK IN 1875. BY 1916 IT HAD BECOME THE LARGEST ASSOCIATION OF BANKERS IN THE WORLD. ITS MEMBERSHIP INCLUDES ALL OF THE LARGER BANKS IN THE U.S. AND MOST OF THE SMALLER ONES. IT HOLDS ANNUAL MEETINGS WHICH HAVE BECOME OF INTERNATIONAL IMPORTANCE.

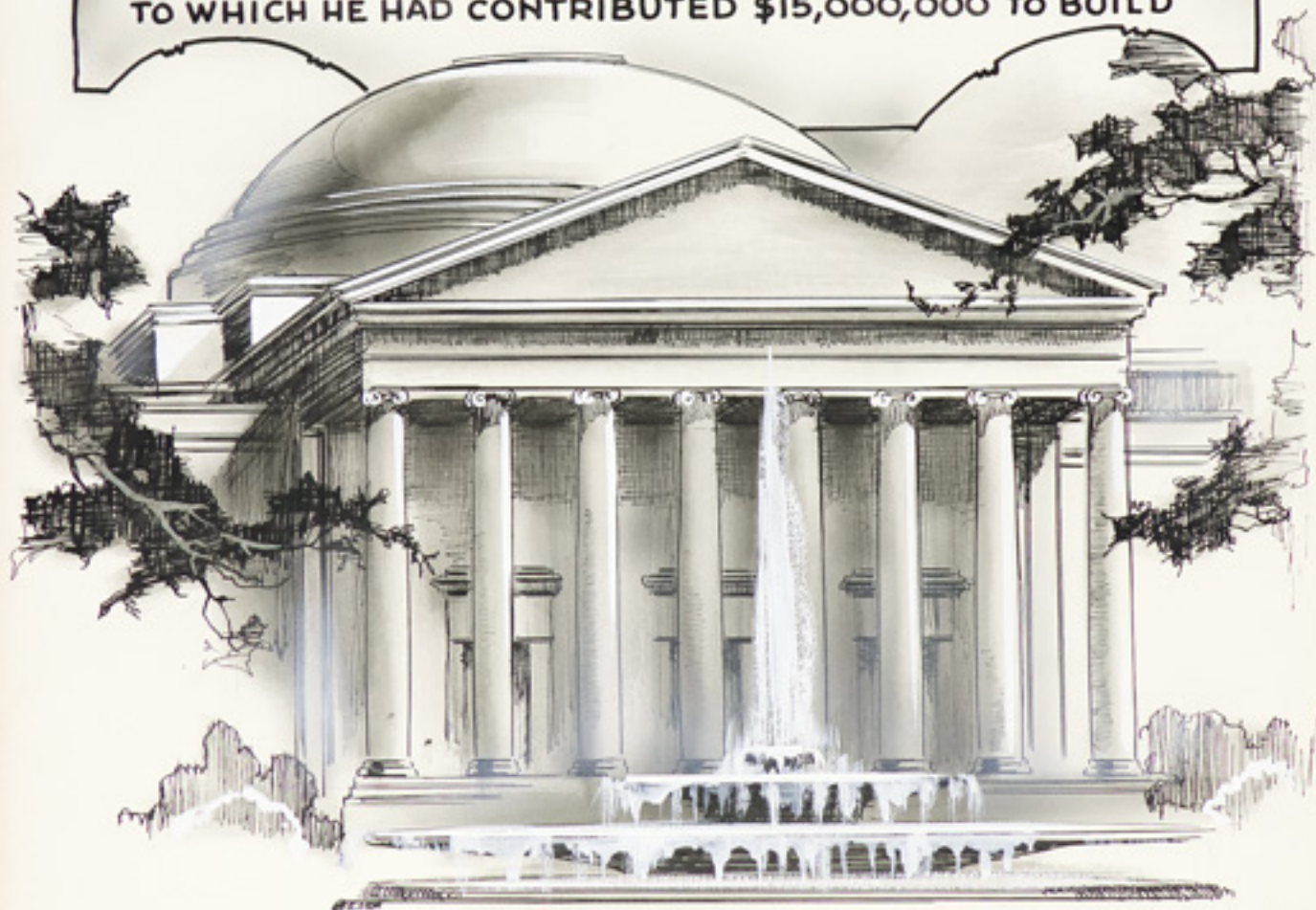

The Maryland Legislature granted a charter to "The Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company" on February 28, 1827.

This was the beginning of the nation's transportation by rail—and of the railroad that grew up with the United States. First rail units were horse-drawn stage coaches. Steam was introduced on a practical scale in 1831.

The modern B&O has grown to be one of the nation's great rail systems, with 6000 miles of line, 2000 locomotives and 100,000 cars.

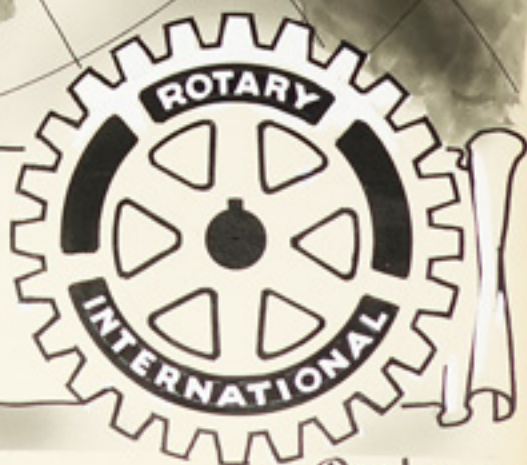

FORT BLISS, TEXAS

The first units of the U.S. regular army were established on the site of what is now El Paso on February 11, 1848. The location of the fort was moved six times, finally becoming permanent on Lanoria Mesa, where the present Antiaircraft Artillery center, the largest in the United States, is located. In early days the principal mission of the troops was to keep Indians from ravaging settlers.
