86 (3 or 4); Type I, dull blue stamp postmarked by both A-26a and A-27a on the same day, and sent via Northeastern RR to Monck's Corner.



On Oct. 16 this cover was postmarked Lancaster, N.Y. (Near Buffalo, N.Y.). Directed to Lieut J. F. Bingham, Brooklyn, L. I. (Long Island) to be forwarded Box 192.

It was forwarded to John Bingham, Lieut. Company D, Volunteer Engineers (Col. S---?) Fortress Monroe Virginia on Oct. 27 from Brooklyn by boat sailing from Brooklyn and received by Lieut Bingham on Nov. 5th.

Was soldiers mail for Fortress Monroe and other Northern occupied points forwarded from a box in Brooklyn for sailings to these points? Note grid cancellation on forwarding stamp put on at Brooklyn.
