THE WAR OF 1812



On June 18, 1812,
the United States declared war
on Great Britain.
President James Madison charged
the British with violating the
nation's sovereignty by restricting
American trade with Europe
and by removing seamen
from American merchant ships
and forcing them to serve

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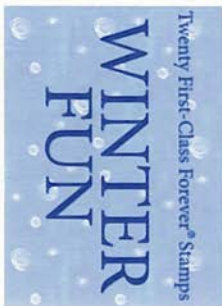
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Ray Charles
