THE CAMPAIGN OF 1920

Facing a hopeless deadlock, Republican party leaders met in a smoke-filled room to produce the name of little-known, handsome and congenial WARREN G. HARDING, a man who could take orders. JAMES M. COX, liberal governor of Ohio, won the Democratic nomination on the 40th ballot. He and running mate Franklin D. Roosevelt promised to pursue the dying President Wilson's dream of a League of Nations. But the nation, tired of war and idealism, elected Harding and Calvin Coolidge, who promised a return to "normalcy." In a historic landslide - 16 million votes to 9 million.

THE CAMPAIGN OF 1928

"I do not choose to run" in 1928, said President Coolidge, and the Republican nomination fell to his secretary of commerce, HERBERT HOOVER, who promised "two chickens in every pot and a car in every garage." The Democrats nominated New York's "Happy Warrior," ALFRED E. SMITH, a Catholic and a wet. Smith faced virulent slander as anti-Catholic talk and literature flooded the country. Hoover was unbeatable; many Americans were prospering at the stock market. In a landslide, he and Charles G. Curtis swept 46 of the 48 states, 21 million votes to Smith's 16 million.
