One of the most popular Presidents of this century, Ronald Reagan was born in Tampico, Illinois on February 6, 1911. He began his career as a radio sports announcer, before moving to Hollywood to become a screen actor. In the 1950s and 1960's, he began a successful new career in television.

In his first bid for public office in 1966, Ronald Reagan was elected governor of California. His communications skills, coupled with his success in achieving the program he had outlined for the state, quickly brought him to national prominence.

After two previous unsuccessful bids, Ronald Reagan won the Presidential nomination of the Republican Party in 1980. In the

ensuing election, he soundly defeated incumbent Jimmy Carter. Four years later, he scored an even greater reelection victory over former Vice President Walter Mondale.

President Reagan's unwavering patriotism and belief in the individual strike a responsive note in millions of Americans. With the support of the American people, he has been able to achieve many of his domestic and foreign goals.

One of the crowning achievements of President Reagan's administration was his "summit" meeting with Soviet leader, Mikhail Gorbachev, in November 1985. It was widely viewed as a positive first step toward easing the tensions between the two world superpowers.

The state of President Reagan's birth is saluted with this 6¢ Illinois Statehood stamp that was issued on February 12, 1968 in Shawneetown, Illinois.



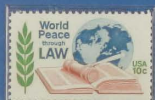
Symbolizing President Reagan's service in the Army Air Corps during World War II, this 3¢ Army stamp was issued on September 28, 1945 in Washington, D.C.



Ronald Reagan's two terms as Governor of California are represented by this 3¢ California Statehood stamp that was first issued in Sacramento, California on September 3, 1950.



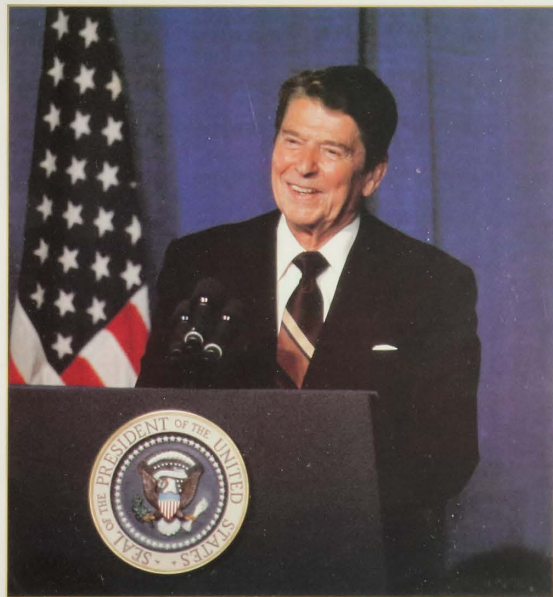

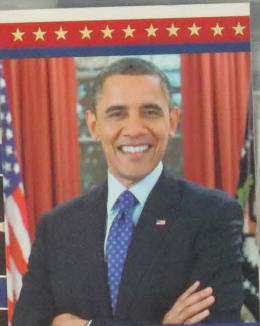
