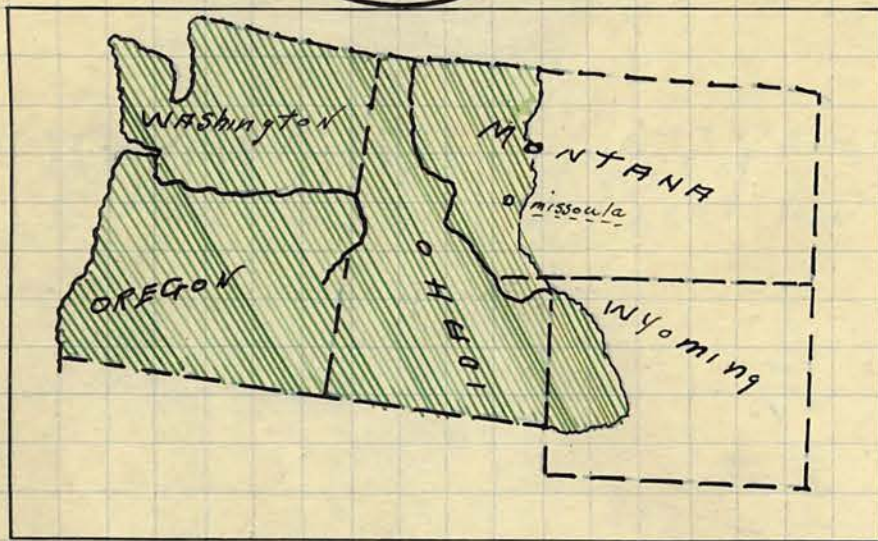

Shaded Area Shows original Oregon Territory

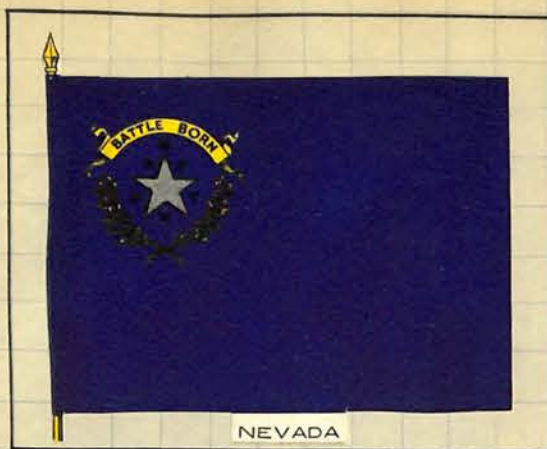

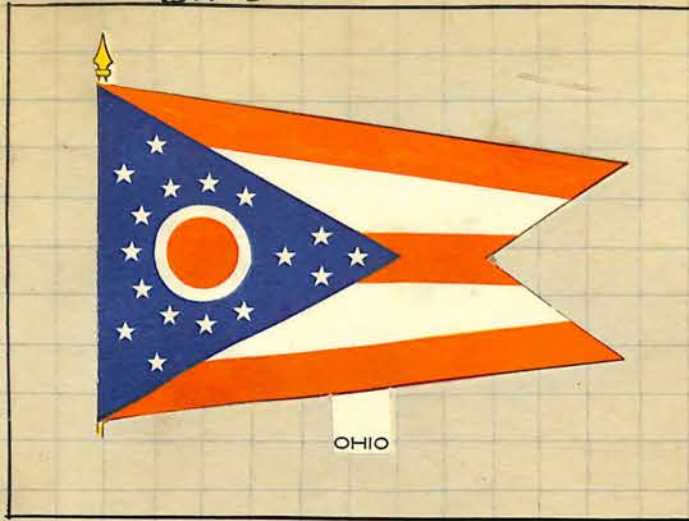

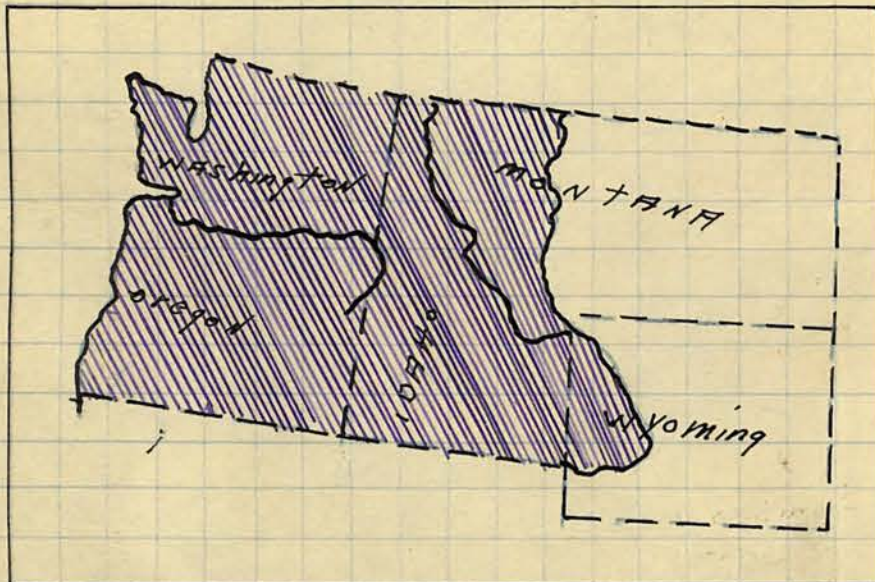

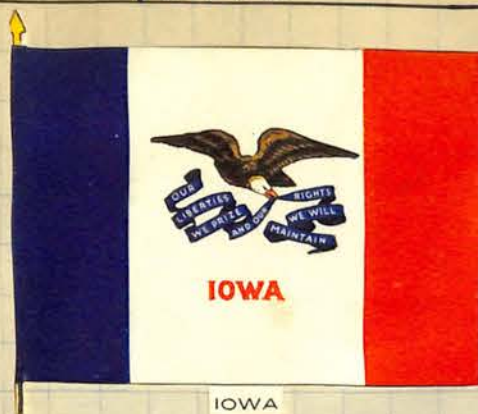
